

hehu Idris was born in the ancient city of Zaria, the Nigeria's City Center of Learning (Home of Learned Scholars), on 20th February, 1936 into the family of Malam Abdulkarimu (the founder of Katsinawa Ruling House of Zazzau), through his Mother, Malama Aminatu and his Father, Malam Idrisu Sambo (Mai Anguwa).

Like any other Child born into Muslim family, the young Shehu was enrolled into Qur'anic School at the early age of 11 years, from 1947 to 1950. He equally had his western education at Zaria Middle School from 1950 to 1955, where he joined the reknown Katsina Training College (KTC).

After completing his KTC in 1958, he proceeded to the Institute of Administration, Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria from 1961 to 1962, and 1963 to 1965 respectively. Shehu Idris attended Staff Development Center, Kaduna and Public Administration institute, Australia from 1968 to 1969.

Alhaji Shehu Idris started his career as a Primary School Teacher in 1958, and rose to the position of Head Master in 1961. He also worked with Zaria Native Authority, Treasury division from 1961 to 1962. Thereafter he joined the Zazzau Emirate Council as Principal Private

Secretary to the then Emir of Zazzau, Alhaji Muhammadu Aminu (the 17th Fulani Emir of Zazzau).

Let me point out here that, Muhammadu Aminu was the grandson of Malam Abdulkarimu, the third Fulani Emir of Zazzau and founder of Katsinawa ruling Clan).

Alhaji Shehu Idris served with the Ministry of Local Government Northern Region in 1963, again as Secretary, Zaria Local Council Authority and Liaison Officer between Government and Local Authority from 1973 to 1975.

He was Appointed as Dan Madamin Zazzau and District Head of Birni da Kewaye (Zaria City and its Environs) in 1973, the appointment he held until 1975.

uguri in Bauchi State is a region of ancient history and modern relevance. Among the factors that make Duguri famous are that it is a district in Alkaleri Local Government Area Council having borders with three states, namely, Gombe, Plateau and Taraba States. Duguri's neighbours within that vicinity are four local government area councils, namely, Akko and Shongom in Gombe State, Kanam in Plateau State and Tafawa Balewa in Bauchi State. From Duguri's blessed standing and geographical location, therefore, come Duguri's fame, legend, history and modern relevance as a region of generous people who believe in sharing and peaceful coexistence.

Duguri's enviable position and reputation started from its mythology. According to Duguri legend, Duguri came into existence from the adventures of three brothers, Tunturi, Nimbi and Turi. The story goes that three brothers, Tunturi, Nimbi and Turi left their homes in Ngazargamu and migrated eastward, seeking for greener pastures, or the need to proof themselves. The legend stated that the three brothers may have belonged to the royal family or were just courageous men.

In the Duguri legend, Nimbi, the elder, had vast knowledge in herbs and medicinal plants, which made him a traditional herbalist. Tunturi was second in rank and was skilled in farming, while the youngest, Turi



exhibited his skills in hunting. He was said to possess weapons that both helped him hunted games and protected his brothers from ambush attacks by people or wild animals.

According to the legend, Nimbi treated and cured their ailments and Tunturi provided food for survival. The narrative stated that the three brothers, after years of travelling, eventually settled at Lame/Burra (now a game reserve in Bauchi State) for a while and moved to a place where Nimbi found abundant herbs and medicinal plants. This place is now called Ningi, a Local Government Area of North-West Bauchi State and home to the Ningawas. Staying in the new settlement helped him developed his skills more, while his brothers moved southwards, through the

forest of Yadagungume to a place called Bununu.

Turi had to move on, further south due to shortage of games in the Bununu area. He was said to have made allies in many villages where he met people and settled for a while. His hunting skills and generous nature of sharing his meat with people made him adapt easily to his newly found environments. He naturally protected the people he met, taught them hunting skills and gained their trusts. They, in turn, looked up to him whenever there was imminent danger.

These leadership qualities of Turi were soon noticed and acknowledged. According to the Duguri legend, in those days the strong and capable, whether locals or strangers, were considered leaders, as most communities did not bother themselves with leadership, since there was mutual understanding between them. What they cared about was their religious beliefs, and never relinquished the priesthood to outsiders. Leadership and protection were believed to be hectic and time consuming, therefore it was befitting of a strong stranger whom they saw as a servant that served them.

his feature which came from many sources, highlights the brief history of Zazzau Emirate, from the days of the Habe rulers to the 1804 Islamic revolution by Sheikh Usman Dan Fodio, inception of the successive Fulani dynasties, the coming of British colonialists and their conquest of the entire northern Nigeria and subjugation of the emirate system under colonial style of administration. Eminence Royalty Magazine International worked thoroughly to ensure that all the contents are genuine and accurate. Below is the feature for our readers to enjoy reading

#### Zazzau Before and After 1804

The ancient city of Zaria was established as the seat of the throne of Zazzau more than 700years ago, while the whole kingdom of Zazzau is about 1000 years old and is among the oldest and most populous kingdoms in Northern Nigeria. The emirate is situated in the centre of Northern Nigeria, and at present covers an area of approximately 20, 800 Sq Km, Located between latitude 9 and 12 degree North and Longitude 7 and 9 degree East.

Zaria, the administrative headquarters of Zazzau Emirate, is named after the younger sister of the famous Queen Amina, who conquered and annexed almost all the important Hausa States. Evidences of her conquests are still visible in some of the Hausa towns, where the security walls (Ganuwar Amina) still exist.

As a result of successful

expeditions, especially during the reign of Queen Amina, (whose activities have gone down into the books of history), the frontiers of Zazzau were extended to cover the present day Nasarawa State, its boundaries reached, Niger, Kano, Plateau, Katsina and Bauchi States. By the close of the 18th century, the Kingdom of Zazzau covered an area of about 37,850 Sq Mls. Therefore, it is important to know that within what period, the capital of the kingdom was transferred from Turunku to Kufena (Kufena rock can be sighted from emir's palace) and finally to Zaria city, due to its favorable geographical location.

The long reign of the Habe (Non-Fulani rulers) ended in the early part of the 19 century as a result of the Fulani conquest of 1804. The Habe produced sixty emirs.

#### The Advent of Fulani Administration in 1804

Following the success of Danfodio's Islamic revolution in 1804, some prominent Fulani scholars were given flags (symbol of authority, or permission) to carry out administrations in their respective places. Their names are shown in Appendix 'B'.

Mallam Musa (founder of Mallawa dynasty in Zazzau) became the flag bearer in Zaria, and was accompanied by Mallam Yamusa (founder of Bare-Bari dynasty in Zazzau) and Malam Abdulkarimu (founder of Katsinawa dynasty in Zazzau) on

the instruction of Danfodio.

On arrival to Zaria, the envoy attempted to enter into the city through Kofar Doka, but when they failed, they entered through Kofar Bai. This event marked a turning point in the history of Zazzau. The coming of the Fulani brought about the emergence of four ruling houses or dynasties i.e. Mallawa, Bare-Bare, Katsinawa and Sullubawa. From then onward, the appointment or selection of an emir is from these dynasties.

It should be noted, that their administration transformed and improved on the lives of the people, not only politically, but also socio-economically, and educationally as there was greater quest for knowledge which eventually, led Zazzau to become the centre of Islamic

education in Hausa land.

This tradition continued even after the emergence of the western education. As can be seen the emirate is blessed with a number of institutions, including the premier University, Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, the Nigeria Defence Academy (N.D.A), Nigeria Air Force Training Command, Nigeria College of Aviation Technology, Nigerian Institute of Transport Technology (N.I.T.T) Federal College of Education (F.C.E) Nuhu Bamali Polytechnic, Depot Nigerian Army, Nigeria Military School (N.M.S) National Animal Production and Research Institute (N.A.P.R.I) Leather Research Institute National Research Institute for Chemical Technology (NRICT).

Presently, Zaria is cosmopolitan, with all the tribal nationalities from all parts of Nigeria and other West African countries co-existing harmoniously, in the midst of the warm receptive traditional values and norms of the people of Zazzau.

#### Zazzau under the British From 1900

Zazzau continued to flourish under the Fulani ruler ship, with an organized political system, until the coming of the British in 1900. So far the number of Fulani Emirs in Zazzau reached 18. Their names are presented in Appendix 'C'

The declaration of the protectorate of Northern by the British in 1900, only increased the intrusion of the British into the Northern part of Nigeria in order to achieve their economic and political objectives of colonialism which started in Bida and Kontagora in Niger state, where the Emirs were deposed and new ones were replaced by the British. This action was indeed followed by a strong current of resistance from the caliphate, as Sultan Abdulrahman wrote a letter to Lord F.D. Lugard, which drew a battle line between the caliphate and the colonialists.

What happened in Zazzau emirate, on the instruction of the Emir of Zazzau, Mallam Kwasau, to his vassal state to resist the Europeans, was that the Emir's representatives in Keffi, now in Nasarawa State, Magaji Danyamusa, started a problem which did not only cost Emir Kwasau his throne but also sowed the seeds of discontent that eventually paved the way for the colonization of Northern Nigeria, as Zazzau, Kano Sokoto and Katsina where conquered by 1903.

#### Durbar

Since independence, Zazzau has been growing as Kaduna, a district under the emirate then. became the seat of Government of the defunct Northern region, after the colonialists' decision to relocate their headquarters from Zungeru. Durbar is one of the traditional festivities that Zazzau Emirate is Known to have been holding in honour of great leaders, for example in Kaduna in 1956, a durbar was organized to honour her majesty Queen Elizabeth II. There was also in 1971 another durbar to honour Emperor Haile Selassie of Ethiopia. Another followed during the FESTAC celebrations of 1977. In recent past we had the NAFEST durbar in 2005 and the Common Wealth Parliamentary durbar in 2006 in Zaria. And the centenary Drubar held in Kaduna 2019. It ws a ground 'Durbar' in honour of Kaduna City and it's people on the occasion of its centenary celebration. Such festivities gave Kaduna town and Zazzau Emirate prominence in the promotion of our rich culture and the enhancement of tourism in Nigeria.

he Late Emir of Lafia. Alhaji (Dr) Isa Mustapha Agwai I was the chairman of Nasarawa State Council of Emirs and chiefs, he clocked 44 years on the throne of the ancient Emirate that is located in the Benue Valley North Central Nigeria.

The traditional ruler was a the descendant of Aliyu Ari Royal House and he was born on 15th February, 1935 at Kofar Kaura in Lafia town to the family of Muhammad Al-Mustapha Marafa & Hajiya Halimatu respectively.

During his early age, he was enrolled into Our'anic school in Kofar Kaura, Lafia and after acquiring some elementary aspects of Islamic knowledge and some chapters of the glorious Qur'an, he enrolled into Lafia Elementary School in 1943.

After obtaining his first school leaving certificate from Lafia elementary school in 1951, the

teenage, Isa Mustapha Agwai was admitted into Benue Provincial Middle School Katsina Ala. Having successfully completed his secondary school in Katsina Ala in 1958, from the Katsina Middle School the young Isa Mustapha Agwai later registered at the Institute of Administration, Ahmadu Bello University Zaria in 1958 and obtained his Diploma Certificate in Accountancy 1959.

He joined the service of Lafia Native Authority where he served as Assistant Treasurer, Revenue Officer and later pay-master in charge of the entire market of Lafia Native Authority.

Isa Mustapha Agwai apart from holding several government positions, he held the traditional tittle of Dan Galadiman Lafiya, District Head of Obi. The tittle conferred on him automatically brought him to a position of a full time member of Lafia Native Authority Council.

This also gave him the opportunity to expose himself to Obi District as well as the entire Lafia Native Authority.

Obi was the second largest District under Lafia Native Authority apart from Assakio District and also the most heterogeneous with many ethnic groups among whom were migili, tiv, alago, eggon, Hausa/Fulani among others.

Despite the number of ethnic groups in the Obi District and as

the District Head Isa Mustapha Agwai applied wisdom, charisma, humility in overcoming all forms of instabilities and challenges among different tribal groups in the District.

He settled many disputes and aggression that occurred among the different communities and tribes that made up the District.

As the then District Head of Obi, Isa Mustapha Agwai worked towards rapidly increasing commercial activities and agricultural commodities were produce in large quantities and also large scale farming was encouraged during his tenure.

As a District Head, he also championed the location of mini markets and the renovation, restructuring of Agyaragu weekly market to a better standard with large capacity. Agyaragu market was the largest commercial centre in the Obi District. He mobilized Agyaragu community and the entire District Council collaborated together and upgraded the standard of the market to a better and spacious market.

Isa Mustapha Agwai during his tenure as District head of Obi, acquired a Land Rover vehicle to ease the movement of people within the district, especially during an emergency needs or any activity that may required transportation.

Professor Adikwu who served as the National Coordinator, Science and Technology Education Post-Basic Education Project (STEP-B) from 2007-2013, has undergone several national and international trainings in various fields some of which include training on Drug Development for Third World in Trieste, Italy in June 2006; training on Bioinformatics and Combinational Chemistry, in Douala, Cameroon in December 2007; training at the World Institute on Education for **Development and Competitiveness** on Challenges and Opportunities for Post-Basic Education, in Washington DC, USA in April 2008. He has also trained at the British Council on Global Economic Crisis, in Abuja, Nigeria, in February 2009, and received professional training at the Galilee International Management Institute, Galilee,

Israel in March 2013, amongst others.



Professor Adikwu has won many laurels in the course of his career including: Associate of the Third World Academy of Sciences in Trieste, Italy 2008; Global Technological Entertainment and Development (TED) Conference Travel Fellowship, Arusha Tanzania, 2007; Alexander Von Humboldt Foundation Fellowship Germany, 1999-2000; Matsumae International Foundation Fellowship, Japan, 2002; Federal Scholarship for Best 20 Students, University of Nigeria Nsukka, 1982-1986; Federal Scholarship for Best 3 Students, Federal Government College, Jos to mention but a few.

He has also won quite a number of research grants both nationally and internationally such as the National Institute for Research and Development Grant in 2008; International Foundation for Science Grant, Sweden 2004; Royal Society of Chemistry of Great Britain Grant, 2002; Raw Materials Research and Development Council Grant, 1998 and the Third world Academy of Science Research Grant, 2004.

Professor Adikwu who has also received many nominations and honours was a recipient of May and Baker Prize for excellence in the Practice of Pharmacy (2009) and Nigerian Liquefied Natural Gas/Nigerian Academic of Science Prize for Science (2006). He also

received nominations for membership from several organizations and agencies within the country and across the world. ## Emergence of KANO as Emirate under Sokoto Caliphate

rom historical sources, there is a story that the emergence of Kano as emirate under Sokoto Caliphate is traceable to the ambush led by the seven Fulani commanders on Karaye town, near Kano, from 1804 to 1805. According to a version of that history, the Kano Fulani were in touch with Shehu Usman Dan Fodio long before Dan Fodio's conflict with King Yunfa that sparked off the 1804 revolution. There is in fact a narrative that at least three prominent members of the leading Fulani families who were in touch with Usman Dan Fodio were studying under Dan Fodio at the time of his flight to Gudu. According to the narrative, these members were soon after Usman Dan Fodio's conflict with King Yunfa, sent back to Kano with orders to rally support for a major offensive.

In the account of the narrative, the offensive was eventually organized and launched under instructions of Dan Tunku and the command of six men drawn from the six territorial groups, as follows:

- 1. Suleiman of the Mundubawa Fulani clan in Kano, one of Shehu's most devoted pupils;
- 2. Muhammadu Dabo of the Dambazawa Fulani clan in Kano, the second of Shehu's pupils;
- 3. Muhammadu Bakatsine of the Jobawa Fulani clan, the third of Shehu's pupils;

- 4. Jibirin of the Yolawa Fulani clan in Kano;
- 5. Dan Zabuwa of the Danejawa Fulani clan in Kano;
- 6. Jammo and Ibrahim Dabo of the Sullubawa Fulani clan in Kano. Account of the story revealed that under these leaders the Fulani formed a war camp in the bush at a place called Kwazazzabo 'Yar Kwando about thirty miles west of the city, where they recouped their strength until they were ready to strike. According to the account, the first move by the war contingent which started in the dry weather of 1804 to 1805 was the assault on the neighbouring town of Karaye. This was the headquarters of the Wambai, one of the territorial magnates of the Hausa hierarchy. An interpretation of the story was that the major objective of the Fulani ambush was to forestall an attack by the Wambai on the Fulani unfortified camp. The assault was successful and Karaye, though protected by a wall, was captured.

It was revealed that the loss of Karaye stung Wambai into action. According to the sources, Wambai consequently organized an army and led it against the Fulani at 'Yar Kwando. According to legend, the battle lasted two days but the Fulani eventually won.

In Kano itself, according to the sources, the major battle of the jihad in Kano was fought at Dan Yahaya, about twenty-five miles

north of the city. It was revealed that the battle took place in the dry season of 1806 to 1807. The then Sarkin Kano Alwali is said to have put ten thousand horsemen into the field as well as thousands of infantry. Once again, however, the skill and resolution of the Fulani bowmen turned the tide of war. They won a crushing victory and forced Alwali and the remnants of his army back in the city.

The withdrawal of the Hausa forces behind the walls of the capital left the Fulani a free hand in the country. They put it to good use and soon isolated or eliminated all pockets of resistance. Having obtained control of the greater part of the State, they at length turned their attention to the city. Kano was

earlier than Alkalawa.

It was revealed that after losing his capital Alwali fled to Burumburum, a large walled town in the extreme south of his former domains. Had he been allowed to establish himself there, he would doubtless have become the focus of a Hausa resistance movement which might have plagued the new régime for the rest of the century. As it was, a Fulani force led by Mallam Jammo of the Sullubawa Clan that pursued him and, after a siege of forty days, stormed the town. Alwali was killed and with his death the Hausa dynasty of forty-three Chiefs came to an end. Hausa resistance in Kano was thus extinguished, and with it, the beginning of new leadership structure in Kano under an emirate ship system controlled by the Sokoto caliphate.

The choice of the first Fulani Emir and the division of the spoils of victory among the other leaders was to cause some dissension. Two years earlier Shehu had summoned them all to meet him in Zamfara so that he could appoint a leader, but he was unable to make the journey. Bello had therefore represented him at this meeting, which had taken place just before the attack on Yandoto, and acting on Shehu's instructions, 36 people had selected Sulimanu to take up the command. The choice was not a happy one because Sulimanu was an unworldly scholar and evidently lacked the personality that leadership demanded.

So long as the enemy was in the field, the reformers had suppressed their rivalries and remained loyal to their appointed leader. As soon as victory was won, however, their differences broke out. When Abdullahi went

to Kano towards the end of 1807, soon after the capture of the city, he found the Fulani preoccupied with their worldly rivalries, and at odds with one another. He had some success in settling their disputes, but with his departure they seem to have reverted back to their old status.

At any rate, in 1808 it was considered necessary to send a deputation to Shehu in Gwandu

in order to get the question of the leadership decided. Reading between the lines, one cannot escape the conclusion that the purpose of this move was to have Suleiman deposed and one of the other leaders appointed Emir in his place. If this was the case, however, the attempt failed because Shehu confirmed Bello's earlier choice and invested the unsophisticated and

relatively youthful Suleiman with the insignia of an Emir. To consolidate his authority further, he also gave him a daughter in marriage.

Despite these marks of favor, Suleiman never succeeded in quelling the rivalries that surrounded him or establishing himself firmly on the throne of Kano. In fact, within a year he had a serious quarrel with one of his lieutenants, Muhammadu Dabo, which again required Shehu's intervention.

The persistence of these jealousies helps to explain why in 1809 the Kano Fulani, unlike their cousins in Katsina and Zarnfara, sent no reinforcements to Shehu for the final battle at Alkalawa. The truth is that because of Suleiman's weakness as a ruler the hold which they had established on Kano was at first a precarious one. This was revealed by the widespread Hausa revolts which broke out when Suleiman died in 1819.

In most of the Fulani Emirates when the first ruler died the succession passed to his descendants. That events in Kano took a different course can be attributed to two factors, first, the near-equality of the seven families which had led the jihad and, second, the ineffectiveness of Suleiman as a ruler. When he died the question of who should succeed him was referred to Sokoto. By that time Shehu too was dead and Bello had become Sultan. His choice fell on Ibrahim Dabo, the head of the Sullubawa, who was duly appointed to be the second Emir and who founded the dynasty which was to rule Kano to date.

#### **Exchange of letters Between Emirs and Chiefs**

LETTER No. 120.

FROM Dan Dalhatu Abdulkadiri, son of Sarkin Zaria Abdullahi to Sarkin Kano Aliyu, greetings, etc.

After greetings—to inform you that three Christians and their soldiers have arrived and are camped near the east of their former halting place on the Likoro road. Exther the Christians have collected men and made them work. They have given orders that every chief shall set four men in work to clear the road and they have done so. Further we have heard that the Christians from Bauchi are coming to join them. This is to inform you that heavy trouble has come upon as, for by Allah we can neither stand nor sit, and have no power to remain in the same place with them. May Allah protect us and you from all trouble and misfortune by the protection of the Prophet.

#### LETTER No. 121.

FROM Dan Dalhatu Abdulkadiri, son of Sarkin Zaria Abdullahi to Sarkin Kano Aliyu, greetings, etc.

After greetings to inform you that the Mristians who I told you were coming from Bauchi have appeal. Maijimina has come and those with him and others. Also that you may know that they are assembling and intended go to Kano. May Allah think of us and protect us. He is the hearer of the prayers of those who pray to him. We beseech Allah to scatter their company and disperse their cathering. May He instil fear and trembling in their hearts and grant you victory over them and also to all Moslems. Peace.

#### LETTER No. 122.

From Ahmadu Sarkin Bornu, 7th Emir of Missau, 1900-1903. See (e) of notes to Letters Nos. 93-99. Same reference as above.

Letter No. 119.

From Dalhatu Magajin Gari, son of Yero (Usumanu), 11th Emir of Zaria, 1890-1897—Bornu dynasty. This Letter describes preparations for the march on Kano, which took place in January, 1903. Dalhatu was made Emir of Zaria 1921 in succession to Aliu dan Sidi.

Letter No. 120.

From Dan Dalhatu Alexandiri, son of Abdullahi, 8th Emir of Zaria—Bornu Dynasty existended from Yamusa, Mallam Musa's Madaiki. This lettan was obviously written in the time of Kwassau, 12th Emir, 1897-1902, who also belonged to the Bornu Dynasty. Kwassau was deposed and deported to Lokoja where he died in 1907. Likoro now on the railway is about twelve miles North-East of Zaria town.





The continued agitation by some communities of the state to have an independent chiefdom that will cater for their yearnings and aspirations have also contributed to the growing numbers of the

chiefdoms It egally has a seansoned administrator and an icon of peace in person of Alhaji Shehu Idris as the Chairman of Traditional council of the chiefs. His wisdom and that of the other Emirs and chiefs have often come into play to stabilize the state during rancour and chaos.

The relative peace witness in the state today is due to this factor. In addition, the state government under the leadership of Mallam Nasiru El-Rufai through the commissioner for local government and chieftaincy affairs, Prof. Kabir Mato have continued to exploit avenues through the traditional

institutions to ensure long lasting peace in the state. The weekly security council meeting in the state is one of such avenues.

These meetings and others have no doubt ensure continuous harmony among the state government and the Emirates and chiefdoms on one hand. On the other hand it avail the Emirs and chiefs of the state the rare opportunity of meeting and interacting with another, this will certainly go a long way at strengthening peace and harmony in the state.

In the Interview the Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau reminisces on his family background, his connection with His Highness, the Emir of Zazzau, Alhaji Dr. Shehu Idris, CFR, which make this interview his homage to the Emir. The interview showcases the joys, fulfillment and gratitude of the Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau for his royal tenure and activities at the Emir's palace and at the local government till his subsequent retirement and appointment as District Head of Maigana, all of which constituted the lessons he imbibed from his 25 years' anniversary as the Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau. Eminence Royalty Magazine International: Maigirma wakilin fulanin zazzau can you please briefly tell us about you, and your relationships with His Highness the Emir of zazzau?

Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau: I am Muhammad Buhari Abdu, son of Alhaji Abdulmutallab Muhammad. I was born at Rimin Tsiwa Zaria city and I belong to Katsinawa Dynasty of Zazzau, emirate from the founder Malam Abdulkarim Sarkin Zazzau, the father of Malam Sambo Sarkin Zazzau who was the father of Mallam Kasimu Sambo, the grandfather of my father Alhaii Abdulmutallab Muhammad who gave birth to me on the 15th November 1957 (61 years ago). I sincerely appreciate and extend my regard to His Highness the

Emir of zazzau who was born to Alhaji Idrisu Autan Sambo, the brother of Malam Kasim Sambo. I was brought up at Rimin Tsiwa when the emir was at the same area till the time he became the emir in 1975. He usually came to our house to see my grandfather Mallam Muhammadu Mairiga and my father. He was so lively with me and I become very acceptable to him he regularly gave me money to go to school since my primary school when I was young. He continued giving me money up to my secondary school level. He was so kind to me with persisting kindness and gift and never treated me harshly hence I became as close to him as my father and my grandfather whom I learned Quranic recitation from in the same compound. I often followed him to his house and to his palace from then to this age (of 61) to pay homage for his good deeds to me.

ERMI: when were you exactly turbaned as Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau? What can you say about your royal tenure of 25 years as Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau title holder? How do you express your happiness and what are your vote of thanks to His Highness and the zazzau Emirate Council for you working with them for 25 years?

Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau: I was turbaned as wakilin fulanin zazzau on Friday 7th January 1994 at Malam Musa Hall after Juma'at prayer. I have been comfortable holding the title till date and I am now 25 years as the title holder. I was so greateful and happy when I was turbaned as Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau at the age of 37.I inherited the title of Wakilin Fualni from the junior brother to the Emir who has the title of Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau. which made me so important and highly respected by the general public of Zazzau Emirate Council.

I am really grateful to all my friends for their contribution in the successful discharging of this assignment. I was equally delighted when I was appointed the District Head of Maigana on the 5th October 2010 immediately or shortly after 3 month of my retirement from the local government service. I held the position for over 8 years still i was conferred and turbaned with the title of Wakilin Fulanin Zazzau.

I am so grateful to Allah (SWT) and to His Royal Highness for such an honor given to me. I am

# Another Insight on Emir of Zazzau, Zazzau Emirate, Origin/Relevance of Some Titles in Zazzau Emirate, about Emir's Aids & their Praise Epithets along side many Traditions in Zazzau Emirate

(Culled from Historical Origin of Traditional Title Holders in Zazzau Emirate, a book written by Abbass M. Fagaci - Sarkin Ayyukan Zazzau)

mir of Zazzau is the highest official title holder ✓Zazzau Emirate responsible for the governance and protection of people in the Emirate. Issue like justice, obedience, peace and obeying law of the religions rest on his shoulders, Zazzau Emirate consist of Zaria and other districts and Zaria is the capital. Emir of Zazzau is the person who appoints district heads to various districts. He is the highest official in Emirate and is referred to as Mai Girma Sarkin Zazzau (His Highness) these titles are used as a sign of respect to the Emir.

Emir of Zazzau's council is divided into: District heads who belongs to the council, District heads who are descents of the Emir, and district heads who have territories but are not the decendants of the Emir, while Yaran Sarki are officials who carry out various jobs for the Emir such as Shantali, Shamaki, Kilishi, Baraya, Sarkin Dogarai, Sarkin Zagi, Sarkin Lema, Maja Sirdi, Madaucin Cikin Gida, Sallama, Etc.

## Zazzau as one of the Seven Hausa States:

Hausa state were said to be established under Abu Yazidu popularly known as Bayajida, the son of Abdullahi the King Bagdad. Bayajida was said to have migrated from Bagdad to Hausa land with a large number of followers, mostly warriors.



He settled in Borno and married Magira the daughter of the Shehu of Borno. The Shehu became very apprehensive that one day Bayajida would overthrow him so he planned to kill him. Bayajidda was hinted of the plan by his wife who was then pregnant, so he left Borno with her to Garun Gabas. After a period of time he left the wife at Garun Gabas and moved to Gaya. The wife gave birth to a boy, who grew up to be the King of Garun Gabas. Garun Gabas is now known as East Birom and is one of the seven Hausa States.

When Bayajida arrived at Gaya, he met some blacksmiths who made a sword for him and from there he proceeded to bravery mad the Queen of Daura to marry him.

Queen Daurama bore him a son,

called Bawo who in turn gave birth to six children. These six children established the six Hausa states.

Gazaura established Daura, Gunguma (twins) on e established Katsina and the other one Zazzau.

Bagauda ruled Kano and Zamagari Ruled Rano and lastly Duma ruled Gobir.

This is one of the versions of establishment of Hausa land, but another version has it that as far back as 1820, Hausa land was under the rule of king of Borno and that Bawo was one of his trusted servants. No one knew his origin, only that he was a trusted servant of king of Borno, who was given so much powers to look after Hausa states when Bawo became old he gave six children the power to look after the Hausa states. Sultan Mohammed was said to have given this version and he too was said to have quoted a renewed scholar called Abdulkadir AL-Mustapha.

Zazzau is a descendant of Abu Yazid (Bayajidda) who established the Habe Kingdom of Zazzau and that is why it is counted among the seven Hausa states. Zaria who was said to be established under Habe Kingdom has a total of sixty (60) kings before the overthrow of Habe by Fulani under the Jihad

Zazzau as earlier mentioned is said to be one of the seven Hausa states. It was established under the Habe. The first King of Zazzau was Gunguma and he was said to have possessed the sword from which and it was during his time that in height. Zazzau Kingdom was consolidated.

Bawo and Bawo was the son of Bayajida. The Children of Bawo founded the seven Hausa state namely, Daura, Zazzau, Katsina, Gobir, Rano, Kano and Birom.

This is the praise epithet for Wali where his position and his responsibility as a judge are mentioned. He deals with transgressors and they are afraid of him because he favors truthfulness and abhors falsehood. And that he is a warrior it is who always successful in war time.

#### Ivan Zazzau:

This title originated from the Habe Dynasty. It is a title for female during that period. It is

conferred on Emir's wife or his mother or daughter (Princess). Her functions include marriage ceremonies in the palace like marrying



in or marrying out or if a slave woman is freed and she is to be married. All these activities are the responsibilities of Iva.

The role of Iya under the Fulani Dynasty is different from that of the Habe Dynasty. Even though there was once an instance in the Fulani Dynasty during the reign of Emir of Zazzau Malam Musa who gave the title to his eldest

daughter (Princess) and she served snatch of Falcon, as the first female Iya during the Fulani Dynasty. But at present, the title is preserved for a Prince and is (Princesses).

#### **Iya Praise Epithet:**

Dafkariri the ash of war, Iya is the gateway to see the Emir, Iya is the gateway to Princes/Princess to see the Emir, About Titles/Relevance of Emir's Son of Uban Gabasawa.

This is Iya's praise epithet where **Shantalin Zazzau**: his functions have been mentioned such as bravery and as a warrior and as a gateway to see the Emir for the needs of people and the princes/princesses. This is because it was a title for the Emir's mother.

#### Dan Galadiman Zazzau:

The title of Dangaladima is a under Fulani senior title for Princes during the reign of Habe Dynasty. Whoever is

given the title is expected to succeed the incumbent Emir after his death. As an important title, it has other junior titles under it. The function of the



title has continued to be except for **Praise Epithet of Shantali:** some modifications which has swapped its role with that of the Madaki, but it remains a title for the Princes under the Fulani Dynasty in Zazzau. The first person to hold the title was Malam Sidi Abdulkadir the son of the Emir of Zazzau Malam Musa during his reign.

#### Dan Galadima **Praise Epithet:**

The Leopard of the city gate, An associate of Murdo the river of Indigo.

This is the praise of Dan galadima in which the significance of the title is proclaimed. He is praised as no longer given to female a chick of an ostrich which defies the snatch of falcon — this means as a Prince, no body can harm him because of the Emir, his father. And he is like a leopard in the field of war. He leads the security operation.

Office of Shantali originated during the time of Habe rule in Zazzau and was given to the servant or slave of the King.

Shantali means kettle. This position is also important rule. It was given to princes during the reign of Emir of Zazzau Yamusa. He is



an official who is always together with the Emir, either in a vehicle or on a horse, and he is the official who welcomes people to see the Emir.

Killer of concubines, the great servant of the King, killer of concubines, the great one of the masquerade, the great servant of the king.

This epithet shows the closeness of Shantali with the Emir.

#### Shamakin Zazzau:

Office of Shamaki originated during the time of Habe rule in Zazzau and was given to the servant or slave of the king. This position is also important under Fulani rule and he has officials An Ostrich chick which defies the under his control. His role differs

during Habe and Fulani rule.

He is an official who is always together with the Emir, either in a vehicle or on



a horse; and he is the official who welcomes other officials in the presence of the Emir when they want to greet him in the morning. Shamaki is an official who is in charge of the Palace in the absence of the Emir.

#### Praise Epithet of Shamaki:

Korau head of slaves, He who beats with a rope. He who prevents free movement, Great slave of the King, Korau owner of a stick. Korau ubangijin Bayin Sarki, Korau master of King's slaves.

#### Madauchin Cikin Gidan Zazzau:

Office of Madauchin Cikin Gida originated form Madauchi and the holder of the title was the

head of slaves during the time of Fulani r u l e i n Zazzau. He is an official who is always together with the Emir, and he is the



official who welcomes other officials and people to the presence of the Emir when they want to greet him. Also, he was charged with safe keeping of the belongings of the Emir such as sword, flag, etc. When an Emir dies he takes the goods away until after the coronation of a new one



#### ....Praise Epithets along side many Traditions in Zazzau Emirate

#### Praise Epithet of Madauchin Cikin Gida:

Mate has meet mate,

Surmounter of obstacle.

About Emir of Zazzau's Praise Singers: The praise song performers of various traditional musical instruments such as kida. Busa, Farai, Kakaki, Jauje, Banga, Kuge, Praise epithet and singing. All these musical performers have their respective heads for their troupe, and each has his councilors. The head of the performing musical troupes are as follows:

- 1. Sarkin Busan Kaho
- 2. Magajin Busan Farai
- 3. Sarkin Makada
- 4. Sarkin Makadan Kulkuli
- 5. Sarkin Makadan Noma
- 6. Sarkin Makadan Kalangu
- 7. Sarkin Kakaki
- 8. Sarkin Kuge
- 9. Sarkin Jauje
- 10. Sarkin Bambadawa
- 11. Magajin Banga
- 12. Sarkin Tambari
- 13. Sankiran Sarki
- 14. Sarkin Gardi

Those are titles for the heads of performing musical troupes and have their various individual functions. They announce the arrival of every district head to the Emi'rs Palace through the musical performance of their various instruments or the specific praise epithet of the district head. They also confirm the turbanning of a district head title or any of the Emir's servant who is given a title performance.

These are the structures of the system of Fulani traditional administration from the Emir to his district heads, representatives and the household title holders: to the Emir's servants and musical and praise performing troupes.

#### Traditions Associated with Selection and Turbanning of A solution to problems, Emirs, District and Village Heads in Zazzau Emirate:

Traditions associated with selection and turbanning of officials differ from Habe to Fulani rules in Zazzau. Some of the traditions during Habe were abandoned because they were un islamic. In the early Habe rule, a new King was taken to Magajiýa (house of Magajiya) where the woman bath him naked in connection with other traditions. Also, on eid day (Sallah day) the Habe go to the Mosques accompanied by singers and dancers and making bonfire during the festivities. These are practices that are contrary to the teachings of Islam and thus they were abandoned.

The Fulani Dynasty went a long way in eradicating the un islamic practices in the leadership of Zazzau. The Emir goes to the mosques on eid day without the company of musicians and dancers. It is after the prayers that he mounts his horse signaling the commencement of Sallah celebrations.

A new official is turbaned with new clothing's by the Emir, after which he mounts a horse accompanied by traditional musicians to his house.

#### Selection and Turbanning of Emirs under Fulani rule in Zazzau Emirate:

through their musical Prior to the British occupation of Nigerian area, the Emirs were turbaned in Sokoto by the Commander of the faithfuls and head of Sokoto Caliphate. In some instances, the Waziri of Sokoto would be sent to turban an Emir and offer him a copy of al-Qur'an, a sword and flag of Usman Fodio. Institutions where the turbaning

ceremony took place in Sokoto, the new Emir would be accompanied by officials from Zazzau such as Chief Imam, Alkali, Waziri and other officials.

The chief Imam would give Our'an to the Emir to Swear that he will lead people with fairness and justice. After the coronation, the new Emir returns home where he is welcomed by district heads and 'ya'yan sarki (descendants of the Emir).

The criteria for the selection of a King are as follows; names of eligible candidates were taken to the Palace of Commander of faithfuls for selection, from the list a candidate would be selected after seeking the opinions of official of Zazzau Emirate Council Kingmakers. Also, if it happened that an Emir was deposed due to some reasons, the deposition took place in Sokoto and the deposed Emir was not allowed to return to his Emirate until after the installation of a new to avoid conflicts.

Today things have changed, when an Emir dies, officials of the Emirate Council nominate a new one and send to the Governor of the State who confirms the appointment. This is followed by fixing a date for the coronation ceremony, which some people refer to as wankan sarauta (coronation bath). On the coronation day, the selected person is dressed in alkyabba (gown) and a turban, he is given Our'an by the Chief Imam to swear to rule with justice and a staff of office is give to him by the Governor. The new Emir is issued a flag of Sheikh Usman Fodio and other items, after which he mount a horse to return to the Palace where people meet him to pay homage.

**ERMI:** Sir, What are your comments as His Highness the Emir of Zazzau Celebrates 44 years on throne?

# Nigeria's March to Greatness Beyond 2019 General Elections

ebruary 2019 is a month to stress the need for successful elections and urge the political gladiators to play by the rules to ensure that the 2019 general elections consolidate the current democratic dispensation and deepen good governance in Nigeria. The primaries were conducted by the various political parties amidst internal challenges and instances of rancour, leading in some cases, to accusations, counter accusations and even. numerous litigations. However, with the successful candidates cleared by the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC), the coast is now clear for the nation to go to polls and elect new set of political leaders to be sworn in and inaugurated on May 29, 2019.

There is no doubt that the forthcoming general elections constitute one of the most critical watersheds in Nigeria's political trajectory since the attainment of national independence in 1960. Apart from the consolidation of the current civil-democratic dispensation, the nationwide polls scheduled for February 16 and March 2, 2019, to elect the President and members of the National Assembly and the State Governors and members of the various States Houses of Assembly, respectively, will

enable Nigerians make a profound political statement that will keep us moving forward.

Unlike in the previous general elections in the country, both the contest and outcome of especially the 2019 Presidential election is being shaped and will most likely be determined more by the perceived pedigree and performances of the major political parties and the individual contestants than by the hitherto prevailing primordial considerations of ethnicity, religion and or region of origin. Specifically one is here referring to the decisive impact of the two dominant political forces, namely, the All Progressive Congress (APC) and its Presidential candidate, President Muhammadu Buhari, and the People's Democratic Party (PDP) and its Presidential candidate, former Vice President Atiku Abubakar, in the process. Indeed, Nigeria has arrived at this interestingly refreshing political juncture on account of three main factors.

One, the Nigerian electorates have been exposed to the governance of both parties and the performance of their candidates who also share similar regional and ethnoreligious identities. Hence, they seem to be more interested in what the candidates can bring to the table in terms of dividends of democracy than where they hail from, or, their faith. Two, because both the parties and the candidates have nationwide spread and

support base cutting across all the states, ethnicities, religions, regions and political tendencies in the country with varying areas of dominance as the case may be, the political gladiators are compelled to distance themselves from the kind of largely primordial and hate driven campaigns of 2015. Third, the gale of party defections which was a major game changer in the 2015 general elections and which has continued even as we are within inch of the 2019 elections. has ensured a realignment of forces and the attendant current pan-Nigerian permutations in both the ruling and opposition circles.

Arising from the unfolding political scenario, it is evident that the Nigerian politics will never be the same again. Notwithstanding the challenges, it is gladdening that with time, patience, perseverance and meaningful participation by all and sundry, viz, the political parties, their candidates, voters, election conductors, monitors and observers, as well as eventual winners and new set of political leaders, the consolidation of democracy and enthronement of good governance is not only feasible, but also inevitable.
