The wedding is historic as it serves as a renewal and the rejuvenation of an old relationship between Sokoto and Bauchi. It is an historical fact that Yakubu Bauchi was one of the original flag bearers of the Usman Danfodio Jihad.

Sultan's Seat



This is a gift sent to Sultan Hassan Dan Muazu (1930-1938) from the king of England, however, the human figure decoration on the seat was against Islamic tradition, Therefore the head of the figure had to be broken off before the Sultan could use it.

Every chief would be accompanied in the field by a contingent of musicians who would play drum, gongs, trumpets and other instruments to herald his movement, encourage his troops and give signals.

The drum in display was given by Waziri of Sokoto, Alh (Dr) Junaidu and originally belonged to the first Waziri Gidado (1817-1842).

The drum was used by him (Waziri Gidado) and all subsequent Waziries when they went on tour of the Empire or made important announcement to the people of Sokoto.

These are the types of staffs of office "Sandar Girma" usually presented to the 1class Emirs, While the small ones to 2nd and 3rd class chiefs most of them were presented during the colonial period (note the crown head of the British) they were mostly presented as a symbol of authority at the royal inauguration ceremony to mark the beginning of a new reign of an Emir/Chief.

At his death, a new staff of office is presented to an Emir/Chief's Successor. This one on display originated from the former colonial (NA) division of Gwandu, Yauri, Argungu, Zuru etc

Sokoto City Gate In 1903..



This iron gate comes from one of the eight Gateways in the city walls of Sokoto (Believed to be Kofar Taramniya) and was in use in1903 when the British arrived Sokoto. It is the only Sokoto city Gate known still to be in existence.
